



## EQUIPALAZONE PASTE E-PP

### Composition

Each unit dose contains:

### Characteristics

Oral paste with anti-inflammatory and analgesic properties.

### Indications

For treatment of musculoskeletal disorders in horses and ponies e.g. osteo-arthritic conditions, acute and chronic laminitis, bursitis.

### Dosage and administration

1 unit does = 1 g Phenylbutazone

|                |   |   |
|----------------|---|---|
| Horse (450kg): | Day 1   | 2 x 2 doses orally                                |
|                | Next days   | 2 x 1 dose orally per day for 4 consecutive days, |
|                | Followed by                                       | 1 x 1 dose per day or every other day.            |
| Pony:          | 1 x 1 dose orally per day for 4 consecutive days, |   |
|                | Followed by                                       | 1.2 dose per day.                                 |

Adjust dose according to bodyweight.

Discontinue treatment if no response is evident after 4 – 5 days of treatment.

### Contraindications

Do not use in animals with cardiac, hepatic or renal disease, do not use in animals with known hypersensitivity to Phenylbutazone. Do not use where there is the possibility of gastro-intestinal ulceration or bleeding, or where there is evidence of a blood dyscrasia.

### Warnings

Do not administer other NSAID's concurrently or within 24 hours of each other.

Use in animals less than 6 weeks of age, or in aged animals may involve additional risk. If such use cannot be avoided, animals may require a reduced dosage and careful clinical management.

The clinical effect of Phenylbutazone can be evident for at least 3 days following cessation of administration. This should be borne in mind when examining horses for soundness.

### Storage

Store at 15 – 25°C. Replace cap after use.

Keep out of reach and sight of children.
