



OTIDERM

Composition

One drop contains:

Enrofloxacin	120 µg
Ketoconazole	240 µg
Triamcinolonacetonide	24 µg

Characteristics

Medicated ear flush used in cats and dogs to clean the ear during an active ear infection.

Indications

Treatment of otitis externa with cats and dogs caused by bacteria and fungi or bacteria sensitive to enrofloxacin and fungi (especially *Malassezia pachydermatis*) sensitive to ketoconazole.

Dosage and administration

Once daily 10 drop in the ear, during 7 to 14 days.

After 7 days the veterinarian needs to decide whether continuation is necessary.

Precautions

Before treatment is started, absolutely sure must be made that the eardrum is intact. The external ear canal needs to be cleaned and dried meticulously. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Contraindications

Do not administer to animals with a perforation of the eardrum. Do not give to animals with a known hypersensitivity to the components in the product. Do not administer to pregnant or lactating animals. Do not use if the animal is resistant to quinolones.

Storage

Store at 15 – 25°C. After opening use within 2 months.

Keep out of reach and sight of children.

Tube of 20 g.
