



## BUTASYL

### Composition

Each ml contains:

Phenylbutazone	186 mg
Sodium salicylate	50 mg
Excipient cbp	1 ml

### Characteristics

Butasyl is a combination of two non-steroidal anti-inflammatory, both analgesic and antipyretic effect. Sodium salicylate is rapidly metabolized and provides immediate decrease in pain and fever. Phenylbutazone provides a longer anti-inflammatory effect. Indicated in the treatment of acute inflammation, and pyrexia allergic conditions present in mastitis, neumopáticos pains, myocarditis, laminitis, and all forms of arthritis (traumatic, infectious and rheumatoid), MMA, bursitis.

### Indications

Phenylbutazone has anti-inflammatory properties. Sodium salicylate has analgesic and antipyretic properties, is indicated in the treatment of allergic conditions and acute inflammation and pyrexia in horses and cattle. Butasyl has a rapid onset of action and a long lasting effect.

### Dosage and administration

Read the general safety precautions for the user before taking Butasyl.

Ensure aseptic conditions during administration. Use only the tracks of deep slow intravenous or intramuscular administration.

Horses:

Adults: 20ml/day

Foals: 10ml/day

Cattle:

Adults: 20ml/day

Calves: 10ml/day

### Precautions

Any person who has been accidentally administered this product should immediately consult a doctor, stating the nature of the product.

### Contraindications

Do not use in cases of hepatic, renal or cardiac failure, gastritis, hemoglobinuria or edema.

Do not administer to horses before competing.

### Warnings

In horses only administer intravenously. Do not give salt during treatment.

### Withholding Period

Milk: 48 hours

Meat: 28 days

### Storage

Store at 15 – 25°C. Keep away from children.
