### Characteristics

### Indications

Uses:

Orally: 10ml, 2 to 3 times a day for 8 days, preferably directly by mouth using an oral syringe

Nebulizer: 5ml, 2 to 3 times a day for 8 days.

500 ml of Balsamic Air will allow 2 series of 8day-long treatments.
